## Castle Rock ranked sixth for growth

Castle Rock was ranked No. 6 on the **Gadberry Group's** "8 from 2008" list of high-growth areas in the United States.

Gadberry, based in Little Rock, Ark., ranked municipalities on census data, weighing growth from 2000 to 2008, as well as from 2007 to 2008. The company also weighted the rankings using some demographic factors, such as ethnicity, household income, net worth, economic stability, length of residence and age.

Gadberry said Castle Rock grew from 9,936 households in 2000 to 24,584 in 2008, by 147 percent.

In order, the top eight were Queen Creek, Ariz.; Enterprise, Nev.; Helotes, Texas; Wesley Chapel, Fla.; Indian Trail, N.C.; Castle Rock; Elk Grove, Calif.; and New Orleans.
